

Summer Camp Photographer Job Description

Purpose: Having quality photos of summer camp is important for several reasons: it helps people remember what an amazing experience camp is; it shows parents and other loved ones how much fun their kids are having during their week at camp; and it is invaluable to outreach efforts as we tell new populations about the ministry of Chapel Rock.

Reports To: Program Director

Key Responsibilities:

- Photographs events consistently throughout each day of camp, in order to capture significant events as well as more laid back, everyday occurrences of friendship and fun
- Meets with camp leadership in order to determine what priorities are when there are competing events
- Makes daily posts of pictures on Chapel Rock's social media pages
- Creates slide shows for each week of camp. Sessions 1 and 4 will require two to three slide shows, as there are different camp programs happening those weeks
- Prints cabin photos and all camp photos each week before Saturday morning, and picks them up or coordinates pickup
- Makes photos available to camper families after camp through a password protected site
- Gives external drive of photos to Program Director no later than one month after camp ends
- Reports any concerns about Camper or Counselor safety to Program Director, Head Counselor(s), or Chaplain(s)

Qualifications:

- Experience taking photos, both still and in motion
- High energy and proactive
- Comfortable with climbing/hiking and other outdoor activities
- Works well with other adults, youth, and children
- Must have completed Safeguarding God's Children before reporting for training week

Length of Appointment:

Training week and all four weeks of camp, May 24-June 27

Dress Code: Dress is casual, comfortable, appropriate for moderate physical activity, and modest
