

Summer Camp Program Staff Job Description

Purpose: Program Staff, including Storytellers, Arts and Crafts Coordinators, Musicians, and Assistants, provide a fun and spiritually rich camp program where young Campers can experience the love of God within Christian community.

Reports To: Program Director

Key Responsibilities:

- Attends designated station for daily program activities (i.e. storytelling, arts and crafts, or prayer samplers), and performs designated function
- Attends daily program meetings at scheduled times
- Assists other Program Staff in supervising Campers during daily Counselor meetings
- Reports any concerns about Camper or Counselor safety to Program Director, Head Counselor(s), or Chaplain(s)
- Assists with set-up, tear-down and other program-related tasks as needed

Qualifications:

- Knowledge of or willingness to learn best practices in Children's Ministries
- Prayerful approach to ministry
- High energy and proactive
- Works well with other adults, young adults, and children

Length of Appointment:

Reports to camp by noon Sunday afternoon and stays through 10:00 a.m. Saturday morning

Time Commitment:

- Participates as required in program planning meetings during the months prior to camp
- Is available during entire three hours of daily programming activities, and at various other times throughout the day
- Has some down time each day at varying times, depending on program schedule

Dress Code: Dress is casual, comfortable, appropriate for moderate physical activity, and modest
